

LE SCARF/LE SHAWL



Materials: Size 11-13 US needles, 2 (8) balls of any “Scarf” yarn. Sparkly/fluffy yarn works best! Approx 150 (600) yards to make a scarf (6” x 52”) or shawl. (24” x 52”)

Cast on 20 (80) sts

FIRST HALF OF SCARF OR SHAWL:

Row 1 and all odd (right side) rows: K 1, (YO, K2TOG) across to last stitch, K1. (Be careful to NOT make a YO before the final stitch)

Row 2 and all wrong side rows: P all stitches

Repeat the above 2 rows until 1 ball (or 4 for shawl) are used up, then change the order of the YO and K2TOG as follows, which will reverse the direction of the bias.

SECOND HALF OF SCARF OR SHAWL:

Row 1 and all odd (right side) rows: K1, (K2TOG, YO) across to last stitch, K1. (Be careful to ALWAYS make a YO before the final stitch)

Row 2 and all wrong side rows: P all stitches

When approx 18” (Scarf) or 45” (Shawl) remains, bind off all stitches. Weave in ends. Add fringe if desired.
