RIBBONWINNER SCARF

One Ball each of 4 yarns...suggestions include:

1. Muench "Touch Me" Velvety yarn
 2. Crystal Palace "Little Flowers", Plymouth "Electra", or Karabella "Magic" or similar sparkly "fans"/"brushes" novelty yarn
 3. Plymouth "24K" or similar sparkly yarn
Berroco "Softy", or similar soft, fluffy yarn
- Long Circular Needle 24" or more: US Size 9

Finished measurements: 3 ½" x 60" (72")

Cast on (210/250 stitches) using "Touch Me". If using long-tail cast on, Knit 1 row, then cut yarn 6-7" inches long and change to a different yarn. If using backward loop cast on, Knit 2 rows, then cut and change yarns. Tie a knot to start the new yarn, then knit 2 rows. Cut and tie a knot after every 2nd row. You can use yarns #2-#4 as often as you like, however, the yardage of "Touch Me" is only 61 yds, so use it no more than every 1" (it takes 13-15 yards for each 2-row "stripe"). Plan to end with "Touch Me": 1 row Knit, then bind off LOOSELY on next row.



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"Come Unwind With Us"

Add fringe to the bare spots on each end of the scarf and make sure all knots are secure. Trim fringes if desired.
